A master brewer recently recognized in the **2020 BBC List of 100 Influential Women** as well as being profiled by Bon Appetit as "quietly brewing some of the best sake in the world". Miho Imada is one of the few female toji in Japan that is taking over the art of sake brewing, an area previously known to have barred female participation. There are around 50 female tojis in Japan.
